Activity Number	Activity (Professional membership renewal period requires 150 points to be accrued over 5 years, with a minimum of 20 points in each year)	Point Allocation
1	Continuing Professional Development	
	Completion of academic courses with conservation content, which results in a formal qualification	30 per subject, maximum 60 points per annum
	Completion of academic courses with conservation content, which does not result in a formal qualification.	20 per subject, maximum 40 points per annum
	In person or virtual attendance or completion of conservation intensive e.g metals conservation, photon, UoM "Graduate Certificate in Art Authentication"	60 points per 5 day intensive
	Attendance at AICCM National Conference and SIG Symposiums and workshops, either in person or virtually.	15 per half day and 30 per full day, maximum 40 per event
	Attendance at International Conference, symposiums and workshops, either in person or virtually.	15 per half day and 30 per full day, maximum 40 per event
	Attendance at AICCM Branch Seminars and workshops, in person or virtually.	5 per hour, maximum 50 per annum
	Attendance or completion of other conservation related courses (eg AIC online courses)	30 per subject
	Attendance; in person or virtually, of courses sponsored or conducted by employer-offering preservation/materials conservation content	5 per hour, maximum 30 per annum

	Mentor as part of formal mentoring program	20 points per student – maximum 60 per annum
	Update of professional information. Eg reading articles and journals	1 per journal/book – maximum 10 per annum
2	Professional Association Activities	
	Participation in the development of AICCM activities, including organization of SIG symposia or other professional development event	20 per activity, maximum 40 per annum
	Executive membership on AICCM National or State Councils	20 per annum
	International membership of conservation related professional organisations	10 per annum
	Executive membership of international conservation related professional organizations	20 per annum
3	Delivery of Public Programs	
	Delivery of conservation related workshops/information sessions outside core work duties, either in person or virtually	20 per session, maximum 60 points per annum (same content sessions can only be claimed once per annum)
	Public lecture outside core work duties, delivered in person or virtually	20 per session, maximum 60 points per annum (same content sessions can only be claimed once per annum)
	Delivery of conference paper, delivered in person or virtually	30 per paper
4	Written Publications	
	Conservation related publication including articles, book reviews in print publications or on an AICCM recognized website (eg. AICCM WIKI, AICCM or cultural collecting institutions, Museums Australia)	20 per non-refereed article, 30 per referred article, 90 per book, maximum 90 points per annum
5	Other Activities
